

SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN WORKSHOP

DATE: March 22, 2017

**Comprehensive Plan Workshop:**

Elected officials present were Mayor Bryce Poland, Lewis and Fisher. Also present were City Manager, Groskurth, MAPA representatives: Grant Anderson and Don Gross, Bob Beattie, Doug Wehring and Kevin Von Weihe. Hadfield joined Comprehensive Plan Workshop after 8:30.

MAPA gave update of activities leading up to this point. Informed those present the Comprehensive Plan is a "Living Breathing Document." It is not meant to sit on a shelf and be forgotten. Goals: are a broad expression of the community's desires. MAPA reviewed goals established from previous workshops. Goals established address Economic Development, Housing, Land Use, Parks and Recreation, Transportation (includes walkability) and Marketing. MAPA lead participants through a SWOT (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats) analysis.
