

**CITY OF TREYNOR**  
**SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING AND BUDGET HEARING MINUTES**  
**TREYNOR COMMUNITY CENTER**  
**MARCH 29, 2021**  
**6:00 PM**

Mayor Hadfield called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Council Members present for roll call were Kyle Plumb and Matt Saar. Justus Brammer attended meeting by phone. Joe Fisher and David Waymire were absent at the time of roll call. Also present: Employees-Michael Holton and Rachel Richardson. Guests-None.

Pledge of Allegiance

**Agenda:** Plumb moved to approve the agenda. Saar seconded. 3-ayes, motion carried.

**Public Hearing Regarding Proposed Budget for FY2022:** Saar moved to open public hearing at 6:04 PM for the proposed budget for FY2022. Brammer seconded. 3-ayes, motion carried. Holton presented the budget for FY2022 and went over the re-estimated FY2021 amounts to Council. There were no citizens present and no written comments received. During the public hearing Fisher arrived at 6:08 PM. With no further discussion Plumb moved to close public hearing at 6:10 PM. Brammer seconded. 4-ayes, motion carried.

**Resolution 21-03-09 – Approve the Budget for FYE June 30, 2022:** Saar moved to approve Resolution 21-03-09 – approving the budget for FYE June 30, 2022. Fisher seconded. 4-ayes, motion carried.

**Permit – Approval of County Request on Lot Split:** Holton provided a sketch plat application from the Office of Planning and Development, Pottawattamie County for Parcel #21026 and Parcel #21027 from Byron Menke for approval. Discussion was held from Council regarding the approval process of property located within 2-miles of the City of Treynor. Holton will discuss this further with Matt Wyant, Director of Planning and Development, Pottawattamie County. Fisher moved to approve the Lot Split Application for Parcel #21026 and Parcel #21027. Plumb seconded. 4-ayes, motion carried.

**Mayor & Council Compensation:** Per Council request Holton provided a survey of neighboring Mayor and Council pay rates to review. Fisher moved to approve new rates of \$60 for Council per meeting and \$120 for Mayor per meeting. Plumb seconded. 4-ayes, motion carried. Discussion was held regarding the process and what would need to be completed to make the changes. Holton will contact Joe Thornton, City Attorney for additional information for the next meeting on April 5, 2021.

Fisher moved to adjourn the meeting. Saar seconded. 4-ayes, motion carried. Meeting was adjourned at 6:40 PM.
