Yard Waste Program

Yard Waste Stickers are required for yard waste pick-up.

Stickers can be purchased at City Hall for \$1.75 ea.

Attach sticker to bags and/or bundle of branches. Pick up is the same time as garbage pick-up each week.

Yard waste includes:

Grass, leaves, garden waste, twigs, brush, and branches 2 inches or smaller in diameter and under 4 feet long.

Yard waste must be placed securely inside biodegradable yard waste bags with tops folded over and not weighing more than 40 pounds each.

Branches & brush must be tied securely into bundles with twine. Branches must be 2 inches in diameter or less, and bundles must not be more than 4 feet long and weigh no more than 40 pounds.

UNACCEPTABLE WASTE:

Litter, trash, street sweepings, sand, or any of the listed items commingled with yard waste, un-bagged or un-bundled items, bags/bundles more than 40 pounds or over 4 feet in length, or branches over 2 inches in diameter.

Dear Treynor Residents,

It is now spring, and summer will soon be on us. Treynor is a fast-growing community that still has the small-town feel. The goal the city council and I have supported is to grow responsibly and do it in such a way that does not take away what Treynor has always been. With double-digit percentage growth over the past four years, we have had to prepare our community in both infrastructure and economic development. To strategically prepare for our future, the city has brought Marketing Hometown America (MHA) into Treynor. This is a successful program that has been widely used in North and South Dakota, Wyoming, Nebraska, and now Iowa. We will be working with the University of Nebraska-Lincoln Extension and with Iowa State Extension to bring this 18-month program to Treynor. MHA will create a positive change that includes:

- Creation of a welcoming culture.
- Place-making ideas for attracting and retaining both youth and adults.

In addition to these activities, the process will help identify the direction that the city will pursue for the next 5-10 years in strategic planning. It has always been my hope to engage more people and to expand the leadership base of the community. The only way that communities like Treynor can survive in this economic climate is to stick together and help each other out. That is what makes living in small towns special. The city has been working hard to get 100% fiber to home through Western Iowa Network (WIN), improve streets, work with Vision Treynor Group and the Treynor Parks & Trails Board to improve the quality-of-life recreational opportunities, provide safe water, compliant wastewater facilities, safe pedestrian sidewalks and pathways, increased retail opportunities, beautification, housing, and increased interaction with EMS and fire protection. We know that all of these are important to the citizens of Treynor. Treynor has become a beacon to other communities in southwest Iowa in how to do things correctly and to show others how we did it. Let us work together to make Treynor have a better tomorrow.
