## Yard Waste Program

**Yard Waste  
Stickers are  
required for yard  
waste pick-up.**

**Stickers can be  
purchased at City  
Hall for \$1.75 ea.**

**Attach sticker to bags  
and/or bundle of  
branches. Pick up is  
the same time as  
garbage pick-up  
each week.**

### Yard waste includes:

Grass, leaves, garden waste, twigs, brush, and branches 2 inches or smaller in diameter and under 4 feet long.

Yard waste must be placed securely inside biodegradable yard waste bags with tops folded over and not weighing more than 40 pounds each.

**Branches & brush** must be tied securely into bundles with twine. Branches must be 2 inches in diameter or less, and bundles must not be more than 4 feet long and weigh no more than 40 pounds.

### UNACCEPTABLE WASTE:

Litter, trash, street sweepings, sand, or any of the listed items co-mingled with yard waste, un-bagged or un-bundled items, bags/bundles more than 40 pounds or over 4 feet in length, or branches over 2 inches in diameter.

## **City Administrator Notes**

Dear Treynor Residents,

2025 is shaping up to be a transformational year for the community. This newsletter informs the public and lets you know where to go if you need assistance. One of the most significant projects for the city this year will be building a new street that will connect Highway #92 with the Heartland subdivision. The street, Zion Drive, will run by all the Vision Treynor Group recreational activities, the splash pad, and Tristan's Trail. This is transformational because it will alleviate traffic flow from the highway and create another path to connect 300<sup>th</sup> Street north to Highway #6 without turning at the four corners. In addition to the safety concerns, the street will connect to the proposed new subdivisions planned for Treynor. The new street construction is slated to start in late April and finish by fall 2025. Some funds have already been committed to the street project, including \$400,000 from a DESTINATION IOWA grant and \$125,000 from the Iowa West Foundation. The city has been proactive in working with partners to assist Vision Treynor Group in their pursuit of building new market-rate single-family homes to help with the shortage of houses in our community.

The wastewater treatment facility for Treynor will be finished this year and functional by August or sooner. The project started in 2022, and construction has been ongoing. The facility will use the latest technology to allow this facility to accommodate our city's wastewater needs and come under compliance with the Iowa Department of Natural Resources.

Behind the scenes, our volunteer Planning and Zoning board, Board of Adjustments, and city council have been working to update our current zoning codes to prepare for our new developments. Working with our Council of Governments, SWIPCO, based out of Atlantic, all building codes will be updated, including our zoning map, showing where we are poised for growth. Countless hours have been spent reviewing changes and needs that will soon be part of the conditions we want people to follow if they wish to reside in our town.

Finally, in addition to the many items listed in the newsletter, we are blessed with four committees of the Treynor's Tomorrow citizens that have worked to make our town cleaner, brighter, more welcoming, safer, and add housing. Throughout 2025, you will see the return of the welcome baskets, safety training on child predator and abduction awareness, signage, beautification, murals, and more. The little things will help Treynor continue to be a place where families can live, grow, and thrive. Together, they make a significant impact on all of us.
