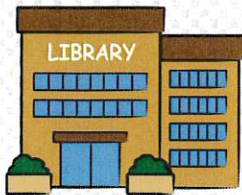

## **City Administrator Notes**

2025 is quickly ending and the year has been filled with many successful projects. Our \$5.8 million wastewater facility was completed during the summer and is not operational. Not only will it serve the current population of Treynor, but it will also be able to be used and upsized in the future to serve up to 2,800 people.

The community came together under Treynor's Tomorrow and the committees that were formed stayed active throughout the year working towards the betterment of Treynor. The signage and beautification committee worked to have a mural that graces our community found next to the post office. They also worked to beautify the community by cleaning up the parks, streets, and schools and meeting monthly to plan activities. The engagement committee worked with the city to increase information dissemination to the citizens. A new website, texting options, marquee, and welcome baskets were just some of their projects. They also came together and held a "Welcome Back to School" party which was well received by the community. The city continued to work with Vision Treynor on building two new subdivisions of housing using tax incremental financing for the infrastructure and construction. The Vision Treynor Group is acting as the developer for this exciting housing development. A tremendous amount of excavation and dirt work was completed during 2025 in preparation for the housing construction in 2026. While all of this was happening, the city was creating a new road that will connect all development.

In October, the city was honored to receive the annual regional award from the Metropolitan Area Planning Agency (MAPA) that includes both Nebraska and Iowa. On November 21<sup>st</sup>, Treynor hosted the Iowa Director of Economic Development, Debi Durham, to highlight all the many remarkable things happening in Treynor.

2026 appears to be heading to all new highs for Treynor! On behalf of the city offices and the city council, I would like to wish everyone a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year!

## **Snow Removal Reminder**

Our City crews work hard to ensure streets are cleared and need your assistance during snow removal operations. Remember that when a snow emergency is declared, there is no parking on the streets, right of ways, or public properties. Also, residents must keep snow removed from the sidewalks on their property. **Snow Removal Tips** Pile snow on the left side of your driveway (when facing your property). This allows you to see oncoming traffic, and when the roadway is plowed again it won't push your shoveled piles back into your driveway.

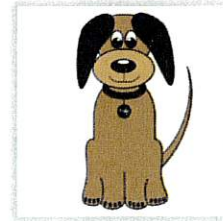


## 2026 Dog License Renewal

If you live in the City of Treynor and you own, keep, or harbor up to three dogs, six or more months of age you are required to license them. Treynor dog licenses are due yearly and expire on December 31, with a penalty being assessed after March 1<sup>st</sup>.

**To purchase or renew a new dog license you will need the following, along with your application:**  
License fee and Proof of current rabies vaccination for each dog. Stop by Treynor City Hall or mail to PO Box 234, Treynor, IA 51575. A \$10 late fee will be assessed after March 1<sup>st</sup>.

**To remove a dog from our data base:** If you no longer own a dog that was previously licensed, please notify our office so we may update our records at 712-487-3787.
